About the Play

In AC/DC by elaine magree, a nurse and her colleagues experience the delight, fragility, and risk of human connection in their hospital during the Pandemic. A trip to Europe planned for March 2020, which takes place in a fantasy parallel universe, refracts the healing power of imagination. An unexpected grandchild brings the abject vulnerability of love. Uncertainty is at the center of their lives; if nothing is sure, and loss is inevitable, why risk loving?

About the Playwright

elaine magree received a BA in Dramatic Art from Pomona College and an MFA in Directing from UC Davis. She has worked at The Magic Theatre, The California Shakespeare Festival, Theatre Artaud, SOMAR, Solano Repertory Theatre, The 54th St Theatre in New York and many other West Coast venues from Santa Cruz to Seattle. She taught theatre at Solano College, San Francisco City College, The East Bay Center for the Performing Arts and in homeless shelters, recovery programs, youth programs and in jails. She was director of The Artist in Residence Program and co-director of The New Music Theatre Project at The Z Space Studio. New work she developed, wrote or directed has been seen at The Marsh, Venue 9, The Working Women's Theatre Festival, Brava, The Berkeley Piano Club, Solo Z, The Maritime Museum, The People's Theatre Festival, and The National Women's Theatre Festival. Her first solo show, Other (previously titled Pilgrimage, Why I'm not an Indian), was produced at The Exit theatre after a run at the Winnipeg and Minneapolis Fringe Festivals. In 2016 her solo show Holding the Edge was awarded the Sui Generis Achievement Award for offering "the public unique and remarkable insights to the pain, love and humor in the AIDs Community, transmuted into healing, through the alchemy of live theater". Holding the Edge was also nominated for a TBA award for outstanding solo production. Her most recent solo show, PussyGrabbingRevenge, was produced and ran to sold out houses at TheatreFIRST and was also nominated for a TBA award for outstanding solo production. elaine was a 2022/23 Brady Fellow at 3GirlsTheatre.

3Girls Theatre Company develops, promotes and presents new plays by women+ playwrights in their prime!

Less than 30% of new plays produced by the American mainstream theatre establishment in any year are written by women. 3GT was founded in 2011 for the express purpose of challenging the cultural bias that favors men's voices over women's on stage. We're proud to be one of the very few theatre companies in the nation that develop and present only plays written by women+.
