NORTH BEACH CITIZENS

DONATIONS REQUESTED: New socks and undergarments for men and women; new and gently used clothing.

ABOUT NBC: We are a community based non-profit organization that utilizes the strength of the neighborhood to effectively address the needs of homeless and low-income citizens through an innovative collaboration of residents, merchants, police, and service providers.

COMPASS FAMILY SERVICES

DONATIONS REQUESTED: Hygiene packets for homeless families: Gallon plastic baggies that include a tooth brush, tooth paste, deodorant, shampoo, hand sanitizer, hand cream, razor, Kleenex packet. These can be full-size or travel and packets for children are also appreciated. All items should be new. We would also appreciate donations of feminine hygiene products – pads and tampons.

ABOUT CFS: Compass Family Services helps homeless families and families at imminent risk for homelessness to achieve housing stability, family well-being, and self-sufficiency. Our six programs provide services to more than 5,000 parents and children each year, 50% of whom are under age 18. Of our 80+ staff members, 57% are people of color, 73% are women, and more than 20% have been homeless and bring firsthand knowledge to their work with clients.

SAN FRANCISCO SUICIDE PREVENTION

DONATIONS REQUESTED: Tea! Our volunteers drink SO MUCH TEA and it really helps them calm down between calls. So people bringing in tea bags or boxes of tea would help.

ABOUT SFSP: The mission of San Francisco Suicide Prevention is to provide emotional support, education, assistance, and intervention as necessary to all persons in crisis and those impacted by them, with the goal of reducing suicides and self-destructive behaviors. San Francisco Suicide Prevention has developed specialized programs in response to differing community needs. This has enabled us to help people who are in pain before they feel suicidal. We feel that making help available early is an important approach to preventing suicide because it reduces the number of people who feel that their pain is intolerable and their future is hopeless.

SAN FRANCISCO COALITION ON HOMELESSNESS

DONATIONS REQUESTED: Blankets, socks and diapers
